The Claimant applies for an order under the Senior Courts Act 1981, s34 and CPR 31.17 (a draft of which is attached) that the Chief Constable of Merseyside Police (the **Respondent**):

- Discloses and permits the Claimant to inspect the documents in its control that are within the classes identified in the attached draft order; and
- Specifies any of those documents that are no longer in its control and what has happened to them and those for which it claims a right or duty to withhold inspection.

The Claimant believes that:

- The Respondent holds the documents of which disclosure is sought;
- Those documents are likely to support the case of the Claimant or adversely affect the case of one of the parties to the proceedings; and
- Disclosure of the documents is necessary in order to dispose fairly of the claim or to save costs.

The Respondent has confirmed (as per the attached witness statement and evidence) that she adopts a neutral position on this Application.

1. On 13 December 2024 the Claimant issued a claim against the Defendants in Schedule 1 and Persons Unknown (as defined fully in the Claim Form) and an application seeking interim precautionary injunctive relief.

2. The injunction order sought includes prohibitions in relation to "Wirral Site", which means Teledyne UK Limited's site at Unit A, 6 Tebay Road, Bromborough, Birkenhead, Wirral CH62 3PA. Specifically, prohibitions on trespass are sought.

5 July 2024 Incident

- 3. On 5 July 2024, three individuals unlawfully entered the Wirral Site and spray-painted the premises in red paint. These individuals also attempted to access the roof of the premises with a ladder but failed to do so. They were arrested by police officers acting for and on behalf of the Respondent and were subsequently released on bail.
- 4. The Claimant suffered loss, by way of repair bills and loss of production revenue, in the amount of approximately £7,500.00.

2 October 2024 Incident

- 5. On 2 October 2024, three individuals gained access to the Wirral Site and climbed onto the roof of the premises. They caused damage to the roof, as well as to the production floor in the building underneath, including by the use of red paint. They were arrested by police officers acting for and on behalf of the Respondent and were subsequently released on bail.
- 6. The Claimant suffered loss, by way of repair bills and loss of production revenue, in the amount of approximately £162,000.00 (with a further £335,000 expected to be incurred in further repair costs).

Persons Known

- 7. The Claimant does not know the identities or contact details of those persons arrested in the above two incidents. It is the Claimant's position that the identities of those persons arrested are known to the Respondent.
- 8. The Claimant's position is that the persons arrested ought to be named and served in these injunction proceedings in order to be subject to the jurisdiction of the Court and any injunction order made. The Claimant therefore requests disclosure of relevant documents in order to identify (and assist with effecting service on) the individuals who have previously trespassed onto its property and been arrested by the Respondent.
- 9. Disclosure of the classes of documents requested will enable the Claimant to:
 - a. add those individuals that it alleges to have committed trespass in the past to the Claim as named individuals;
 - b. effect service of documents on those individuals in the proceedings; and
 - c. commence any further necessary proceedings against those individuals should they breach any inunction order in the future.
- 10. In conclusion, I believe that the Respondent holds the classes of documents requested in the Draft Order, that those documents will support the Claimant's case or adversely affect the case of the Defendants and will assist the court to dispose fairly of the action or save costs.
- 11. I believe that it is appropriate for the court to exercise its power under CPR 31.17 to make the Order requested for those reasons.
- 12. The Respondent has confirmed that she adopts a neutral position on the Application.
